Our Goals....

- Based on the 2010 MEAP "Writing from Knowledge and Experience" student samples, the number of fourth grade male students scoring at a level of 3 through 6 will increase by 5% compared to the 2008 MEAP baseline writing data.
- Based on the 2010 Math MEAP scores, third through fifth grade students will increase their scores in the area of measurement by 5% compared to the 2008 MEAP baseline math data.
- Based on the 2010 MEAP scores, 75% of third through fifth grade students will correctly answer questions using literary devices in narrative and informational texts compared to the 2008 MEAP baseline reading data.
