Please provide the following information to nominate a teacher to receive the Oakland County Outstanding Teacher of the Year Award. Nomination forms must be returned to the Community Relations office at the Troy School District Administration Building. The selected applications of three teachers (one elementary, one middle school and one high school) will be submitted to the Oakland Schools coordinator for the Oakland County award. Per county requirements, nominees must be certified, full-time teachers in grades kindergarten through twelve. Nominees must also have a minimum of five full years of classroom teaching experience.
